



Dear Family,

Spring is here! The flowers, trees and grass are changing daily. This journal activity can be done with your child to help him or her discover the changes related to spring.

SPRING JOURNAL

1. Have your child observe the daily changes they see outside for four days.
2. Have your child record the date and draw a picture of at least one sign of spring observed on that day in the box on the back of this paper.
3. Let your child write words that describe the picture (red flower, singing bird, tall tree). The letters don't need to be perfect and invented spelling is okay.
4. Look back at the pictures together and have your child read the word that they wrote under each picture.
5. Ask your child questions about their drawing (What happened to the tree?).



When your journal paper is complete, have your child return it to class.
